

Java




About Java

Lombok




About Lombok

An island of 4,594 square km, Lombok was formerly a Kingdom with its capital Mataram. The population comprises the native Sasak whose main religion is Islam; the western part of the island is inhabited by Balinese, where the Hindu way of life prevails, complete with ancient temples. A popular tourist destination off the coasts of Lombok, the Gili Islands (or just the Gilis) are very relaxed and laid-back, with countless little beachside cafes serving up elaborate seafood buffets, fresh salads and good quality western and Asian food. All three islands feature superb, white sandy beaches, crystal clear water, spectacular coral reefs, and the best snorkeling and diving to be found anywhere between Bali and Lombok.



Sulawesi

Sulawesi, Indonesia's 3rd largest island is an island of cultural diversity ranging from the mysterious Toraja in the mountainous highlands, to the Makassarese and Bugis groups in the south and Minahassans (Menadonese) people in the north. Sulawesi offers the complete spectrum for the traveler with spectacular mountains, scenic coastline with white sand beaches and first class diving, the fascinating culture of the Toraja and dense jungles. Visit the region of Toraja, where their ancient customs and practices are renowned throughout the Indonesian archipelago. Seek out the Tau Tau statues and the hanging graves, then engage in the daily life of the Torajan people.

Kalimantan Island (Borneo) lies on the equator with temperatures from 18°c up to 36°c in the lowland and 10°c up to 23°c in the moun tain areas. The land is crossed by many rivers, which are the dominant means of transportation and commercial activities, although roads and motor ways have also been built linking towns and villages. South Kalimantan has many special places of interest for visitors. The Barito Floating Market will give you enjoyable trips cruising the Martapura and Barito rivers. You can see how the local people live along the banks of the rivers. Early inn the morning, by a traditional motor boat (Kelotok), see the biggest floating market in Kuin, taste local snacks and drinks at a floating restaurant. Cruise to Tanjung Harapan island and you can observe orangutans and other endemic faunas in their natural habitats along the way. Stop by Tanjung Puting National Park to see protected wildlife.



West Papua



About West Papua

West Papua, formerly known as Irian Jaya, is the largest province in Indonesia, consisting of most of the western part of New Guinea and nearby islands. In 2003, the government Indonesia declares the westernmost part of the island, around the Bird's Head Peninsula, a a separate province known as West Papua. Endemic wildlife that adorns the expanse these vast forests, mountains, swamps, and seas include: strange and beautiful creatures such as cassowaries, dugongs, cenderawasih (paradise), echidnas lay eggs, and monitor lizards that live in trees.

Most of Papua's territory is covered by impenetrable forests and most of it residents live within the forest and around coastal cities. Almost all tourists visit Baliem Valley to see traditional houses, some of the most remarkable traditional cultures in the world. While another interesting place is the art of the Asmat region, or birdlife and coral reefs on the north coast and surrounding islands
